

Dublin Audio Tour

The visitors just need to download the iWalk from the website of tourism department into an MP3 player. The advantage of this product over traditional guide is that the downloading is free and modified to the interest of the visitor like Georgian Dublin or literary Dublin. Downloading of the map from the website is possible or is available in the tourist office. Various themes like medieval Dublin, Rock & Stroll trail, castles and cathedrals and Viking will be included in the impending products. It gives detailed information of the places, the best tour operators, special features of various operators and places the operators operate. Sequence of information about rail tours, accommodation, splash tours, north coast and castle tour, Liffey River Cruises, cycling safaris, sea tours, guided walking tours and tourist offices are available. The walking tour of two hours organized by the students of Trinity College, which passes through the old city is of special significance, is found in the iWalk. The iWalk provides an introduction to the city of Dublin- its traditional stories, great historical places like Trinity College, Old Parliament House, Temple Bar and Dublin Castle. The routes of this two-hour tour passes through Viking and Medieval tour, Castle and Cathedral and the temple bar. The history of the city of Dublin is more than 2000 years. The streets are full with life, from historic Cathedrals to Victorian splendor. The people still remember the old city. There are various packages provided by various tour operators, which range from one-day tour, two-day tour, three-day tour, four-day tour and five-day tours. Tour for a day include a highly pleasurable trip to Cork, Blarney Castle the world famous Blarney Stone and the Queenstown Story on Cork Harbour. A two-day tour includes a visit to Limerick, the Cliff of Moher an overnight stay in Galway City and a visit to Galway Bay. A three-day tour is towards the south west of the country, which includes visits to Cork, Blarney Castle and the Queenstown Story. Night halt includes a stay in Killarney and the next day is through ring of Kerry, Galway Bay and Cliff of Moher and the Dingle Peninsula. This is an excellent tool invented by the tourism ministry and is a handy guide for tourists.
